

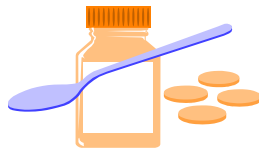

Now that summer is on the horizon, don't forget that your medications need to stay cool too. Some medications need to be protected from light (that's why they come in coloured vials), and all drugs need to be protected from extremely hot temperatures. So if you're planning a driving holiday, remember not to leave

your medications in the glove compartment for an extended period.



When do you use your turn signals?

In an urban or built up area, you must signal your intention to turn while you are still 30 meters away from where the turn will take place. On the highway the proper distance to activate your turn signal is 150 meters prior to the turn. A lane change or any manoeuvre that causes the vehicle to change direction by 1 meter or more requires the use of the turn signals. Correct hand signals may be used if the electronic signals in your vehicle are malfunctioning (burned out bulb, etc.).
