When to use turn signals while driving in Manitoba

- In an urban or built up area, you must signal your intention to turn while you are still 30 meters away from where the turn will take place.
- On the highway the proper distance to activate your turn signal is 150 meters prior to the turn.
- A lane change or any maneuver that causes the vehicle to change direction by 1 meter or more requires the use of the turn signals.
- Correct hand signals may be used if the electronic signals in your vehicle are malfunctioning (burned out bulb, etc.).
