Just take your non-perishable donation to the rear door of the RM Office. There is a barrel just inside the door to receive your tins and packages.

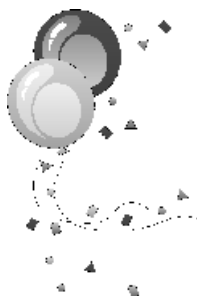

- ✓ Articles highlighting local groups with contact names & numbers



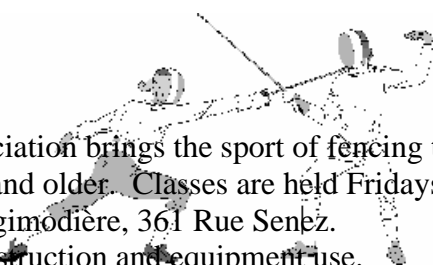
